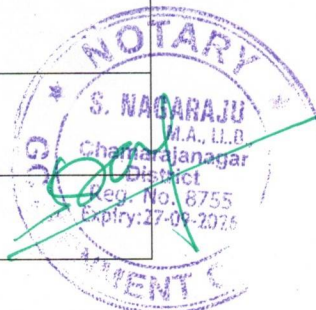

Terms and Conditions :

1. As per the guidelines and rules of Right to Education Act, 2009 and Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the rules thereafter, the school has been registered and renewed the recognition. Running additional classes or division shall not be permitted.

2. The school will function under the rules of Right to Education Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act – 1983.

3. As per the Right to Education Act 2009, 25% of the seat to be reserved for the children from weaker section. Government has the right to admit the students to the school as per RTE guidelines for all the schools coming under RTE (Government has made the rule to admit the students to Government or Aided schools which are in close vicinity of residence of the parents. If there are any such schools then the admission to students will be provided) If there are no Government or Aided schools than the private schools should admit the Government allotted students to their school and provide them the primary education. These students to be given opportunities to continue their studies without any discrimination.

4. As explained in clause 3 above, Government releases school fee as per the rule, for all the students who got admitted under RTE act. Hence collecting fee from these students is restricted

5. School and Governing Council has been restricted from collecting in any form , the Capitation fee or voluntary donations from parents at the time of student admission or later.

6. As per the circular of the Govt. School / governing council shall publish the prescribed website of the board and also to be published in the school notice board. No extra fees, the fixed fee to be collected from the parents.

7. School / governing Council shall admit the students only in the scheduled period of admissions as decided by the government.

8. School / government Council shall not refuse the admissions against the following points.

(i) Lack of age proof document.

(ii) Based on Caste, Religion, Place of Birth, Language.

(iii) Seeking admission after the last date of admission.

9. As per the rules and regulations of RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act safety measures to be taken [Fire Safety and Building Safety certificates from the concerned authority and Learning safety as per {K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R }]



10. School/Governing Council follows the below points:

(i) Shall not detain an admitted student in any of the classes till the completion of primary and middle School or expelled from the school.

(ii) Shall not harass any child mentally or physically.

(iii) Getting pass in any of the board examination is not necessary for a child till the completion of primary education.

(iv) Every child who completes primary education shall be issued the certificate as per the rules of RTE Rule -21 and Karnataka Education Act and rule thereby

(V) School shall include students with Special Education Need / Special children, as per the rules and Provision of RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act,

(vi) The appointed teachers to possess the minimum qualification as per the rules of RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and according to the Government order for Primary and Secondary school teachers.

(vii) Teachers' salary and allowances, service rules and regulations to be as per the directions of State Government. Also as per the notice of the Government [Provident Fund (PE)], salary to be paid through the bank transactions and they come under Employee's State Insurance corporation (ESI) Teachers to perform the duties and responsibilities as per Teacher Act Section 24(1) and RTE Act and rule and also Karnataka Education Act and rules, rule-17. And they shall not engage themselves in private tuition or supervision or consideration of the same

11. School shall follow curriculum and text books as per the affiliated board

12. School shall admit students based on available facilities in the school and as per the Karnataka Education Act and rules Section-19.

13. School shall follow the rules and regulations as specified in the section 19. School staff to be appointed as per the rules and act of Karnataka Education Act.

14. Un Authorized class/divisions should not be opened within or outside the school premises.

15. School building and other basic facilities related to the school shall not be used during the day or night for commercial activities, political activities or non-academic activities.

16. The school cannot be run for the profit of any individual, group or association.

17. The school to be audited by Chartered Accountant and the copy of the audit report to be submitted to Deputy Director/Block Education officer every year before end of June.

18. School to follow Language policy as per the Government notification [Kannada Language Policy-2016).

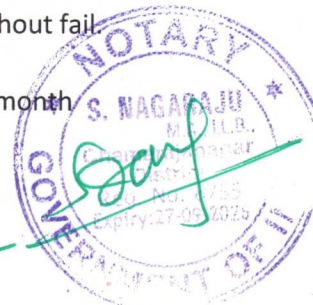
19. Governing Body and teachers to work as per the RTE act and Karnataka Education Act and rules.

20. School/Governing body to follow the rules and directives of Government and board without fail

21. It is mandatory to update in SATS, the school information every year before end of the month March.
